My Dear Mr. Tauscher,

Just a word to tell you that the City authorities have voted \$300.00 for the purpose of covering the expense of transporting the 10 000 plants from the Boyce-Thompson Arboretum, the transportation to be effected next Spring.

We will be greatly indebted to you for so kind an offer and for having taken so keen an interest in the matter.


I am proceeding gradually with the whole matter. I do not want to bother the City with another request just now, but I want you to come here with me for a day or two at my own expense. When would it suit you? I suggest Oct. 29 & 30 if you prefer to use a week-end.

I would also like you to tell me :

- a) the minimum budget to be asked for the season of 1933.
- b) the minimum staff that would be necessary to go on satisfactorily with the work, leaving aside for the time being evrything not absolutely essential.

Just think to it and we will discuss the matter when you are here.
