Annona, *Anacardium*, etc. (for the economic collectors)

Hematoxylum (important as a lab. product)

Psidium Goyave (economic collector)

Crescentia Cujete (curious plant)

I hope you are always getting along well and
that the greenhouses are progressing notwithstanding the
political situation.

I feel quite ashamed to be at large while everybody
is working over there. But I make the best of it to bring
you back a little more rapidly and a little more help
Let me add once more how highly I appreciate
your work, your dignity of life, and high stan-
dards of thinking. It might have been otherwise
and our association could have been solely on
business grounds. Fortunately things are different, and
our relations stand on much higher and on
much more intimate grounds.
