Moonlit Evening¹ - A tour of the Biodôme's ecosystems by night, to spy on nocturnal animals and meet some odd and intriguing characters! - at the Montréal Biodôme

Storytellers and legends - Take a trip through space and time at the top of the world's highest inclined tower. - The Montréal Tower Observatory

Play outside

The Ephemeral Forest² - New life for Christmas trees! The trees are being recycled as part of a collective installation, to become a huge gathering place for everyone. On the Esplanade linking the Biodôme and the Olympic Stadium

Fascinating birds of prey² Come get a close-up look at birds of prey, along with the team from the Union québécoise de réhabilitation des oiseaux de proie (UQROP) Outdoor stage

Les bobeurs² - A hilarious bobsleigh team studies penguin behaviour as a way of improving their own performance. Watch them training and admire their antics. Outdoor stage

Rhythm and nature² - Freeworm presents an exclusive performance of songs in four languages, including the sounds and calls of animals at the Biodôme. - Outdoor stage

A dark taler² - A mysterious figure tells some surprising stories about will-o-the-wisps and a duel with the Devil. - Outdoor stage
